Conditions For Airtech Environmental's
LAP Renewal

- 1) LAP renewal is granted for Airtech Environmental's Denver office only. Separate applications shall be submitted if other branch offices of Airtech Environmental wish to participate in the District's LAP.

- 2) The District shall be notified at least seven days prior to scheduled test dates (if possible) for all source tests performed in the South Coast District which require LAP testing. This notification is necessary in order for the District to conduct site audits of LAP firms. Notifications shall be transmitted to Glenn Kasai by e-mail at gkasai@aqmd.gov, and shall include the name of the facility, the address, proposed test methods, and the name, phone number and e-mail address of the facility contact. This notification requirement may be waived by the District, once a successful audit is completed for the test method.
